

## RULES FOR JR. MISS AND MISS ANGOLA FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS CONTESTANTS

### Rules:

1. Each Jr. Miss contestant must be between the ages of 9 to 14 years and show birth certificate and any size photo when registration is turned in, and Miss contestants must be between the ages of 15 to 18 years and show birthday certificate and any size photo when registration is turned in.
2. Each registration form must be completely filled out and returned by August 1, 2018 4:00 p.m.
3. Registration fee is \$10.00 per contestant and must accompany the registration form, cash only, and a receipt will be available. Checks or Credit Cards will not be accepted .
4. Each contestant will be judged on the following:
  - a. Six (6) questions will be asked in a short private interview per contestant, prior to the program.
  - b. Contestants will be judged in casual wear as follows:

**Ladies**-shorts with a colorful shirt, OR colorful sundress, neither being higher than 3-4 inches above the knee & summer shoes such as sandals or tennis shoes. (Flip flops not allowed)
  - c. Contestants will also be judged in evening gown as follows:
    - \*Dresses may not be revealing in the chest area.
    - \*Dresses may not have slits up the sides of the dress, any higher than the knee.
    - \*Dresses must be floor length.
5. Each contestant must be available the day of the pageant by 9:00 with interviews starting at 10:00 a.m. and the program beginning at at 2:00 p.m.

6. Each contestant will be allowed one (1) person to help with hair, makeup, and changing.
7. Each contestant must live, work or attend school in Steuben County, Indiana.
8. Each contestant must write an Essay on the importance of Arts in our Community, no more than 1000 words and should be turned in with the registration.
