



Angola Art Festival
Saturday, August 1, 2020
10 a.m. - 4p.m.

The Angola Art Festival is an opportunity for artists, artisans, crafters, makers, and buskers to display and sell their talented work in Angola, Indiana during the peak of the summer tourist season.

Guidelines for Artists and Vendors

- All items must be hand fashioned by the artist. No “Buy/Resell” or Direct Selling vendors will be allowed.
- Applications are due by July 8, 2020, with payment of the Application Fee as specified in the Application.
- All applicants must reserve at least one booth space to display their work.
- Applicants will be notified by email by May 31, or within two weeks of receipt of application if after that date, of their acceptance to display their works.
- Artists/Vendors that are not accepted will be refunded their Application Fee.
- The Angola Art Festival will be held, rain or shine, and no accepted artist’s/vendor’s booth space refunds will be made for cancellations.
- There are no booth fees for Buskers or wandering Minstrels – but they must submit an Application Form specifying their type of entertainment and register upon arrival.
- Any food related items must comply with all federal, state, and local laws and ordinances and you must be able to produce the proper permits or licenses on demand.
- If a booth space is assigned on a public sidewalk, there must be at least 5 feet of walkway space to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- The sidewalks in front of Downtown Angola businesses are their frontage and they control their use.
- The Downtown Monument Center (The Mound) and the surrounding ground on which it stands, as well as Steuben County properties, are off-limits for displays.
- All artists and vendors are responsible for their own tables, chairs, canopies, etc. and for their own property. Enclosed tents or sides on canopies are not allowed if they will obstruct business’s storefront views.
- The Angola Art Festival and its organizers are not responsible for artist’s vendor’s lost, stolen or damaged property.
- Demonstrations by artists are allowed but NO hazardous materials or actions are allowed!
- All displays and demonstrations must be family friendly.

Time Schedule Saturday August 1, 2020

- 8–10 a.m. Downtown Angola businesses set-up their displays.
- 8–10 a.m. Artists/Vendors must check-in at the Registration Tent in front of the Courthouse.
- 8–10 a.m. Artists/Vendors set-up their displays at their designated sites, using the above guidelines.
- 10 a.m. Festival begins.
- 4 p.m. Festival ends. Artists/Vendors take down their displays by 5:30 p.m.
